Buehler Obtains ISO Certification for Hardness-Testing Blocks

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and indenters. - Calibration of Standardized Knoop Test Blocks – ASTM E92 and ISO 4545-3
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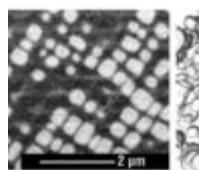
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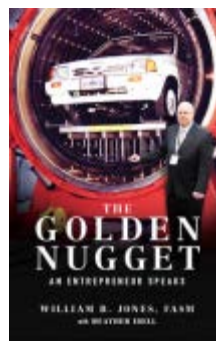
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
